AFFORDABLE CONNECTIVITY PROGRAM

You could be eligible for internet payment assistance through the Affordable Connectivity Program (ACP). ACP is a Federal Communication Commission program that helps connect families and households struggling to afford internet service.

The benefit provides a S30/month discount on broadband services for qualifying households. Only **one** ACP benefit is available per household. This benefit is limited to one monthly internet discount and a one-time connected device discount.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

A household is eligible if one member of the household meets at least one of the four criteria below:



INCOME

A member of the household has an income that is at or below 200% of the Federal Poverty Guidelines.



ASSISTANCE PROGRAM

A member of the household participates in assistance programs such as SNAP, Medicaid, Veteran Pension or Survivor Benefits, Federal Public Housing Assistance, SSI, WIC, or Lifeline.



SCHOOL LUNCH PROGRAM

A member of the household is approved to receive benefits under the free and reduced-price school lunch or breakfast program, including through the USDA Community Eligibility Provision.



FEDERAL PELL GRANT

A member of the household received a Federal Pell Grant during the current award year.
